# IMPORTANT INFORMATION



- **NO VEHICLES** are allowed on site
- **TOILETS** for public use are next to the fence to the left of York Road river bridge. There are also public toilets located diagonally across the Parade, near the Town Hall and in the Pump Rooms.
- **FIRST AID** is provided by 365 Medical and is located by the path near the site entrance on Dormer Place Position O5 on the map
- **LITTER** All litter pickers are volunteers. Waste will be recycled off site. Please put your litter in bins or take it home to recycle.
- Well behaved **DOGS** on leads are allowed on site
- **WATER** is available from the standpipe near Dormer Place and at the Info Caravan.
- Access to the Festival site is fully accessible - if you require any additional information please contact us.
- **INFORMATION TENT:** This is located by the central path near the site entrance on Dormer Place - Position O1 on the map. If you have any queries or problems during your visit please come and find us and we will do our best to help you.
- **SECURITY** We need security on site so we can all feel safe and enjoy the festival. Please treat them with respect and appreciation as they go about their work.
- **ALCOHOL** please be aware that the Pump Room Gardens is a restricted drinking area. Security Personnel have the power to remove alcohol from anyone they consider is behaving in an anti-social manner.
- **TIMINGS** The Festival runs from 10am-6pm on both days.  
As it takes place in a residential area our licence does not permit any events after these times. Please respect our neighbours and leave the festival quietly.
- **ACCOMMODATION** There is no camping on the Festival site. Please contact Tourist Information for details of accommodation.

• The festival aims to finance itself. Stallholder fees cover our costs and hopefully help to put on next year's festival. All performers play for limited expenses or for free.

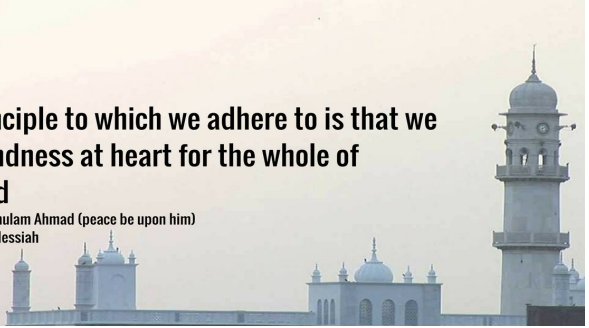

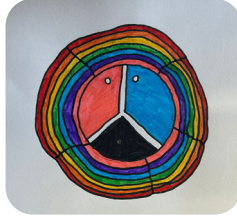

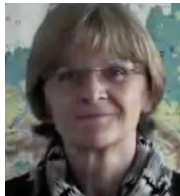

# WORKSHOPS/ACTIVITIES - SAT

Come and raise your spirits, soothe your soul, move your body and have fun with these free taster sessions/mini workshops provided by skilled local practitioners, who are giving their time for free. Places are limited for some of the sessions - to ensure a place, sign up on the day at the Activities tent (or you can just turn up).



## 10:30-11:30 Yoga with Eleutheria Yoga

Join us for a Peaceful Morning Slow Flow, a gentle and nurturing Vinyasa Yoga session focused on breath connection, soothing movement and waking the body up for a beautiful day ahead.

## 11:30-12:30 MELT with Liron Weiss

Experience MELT, a gentle self-care treatment using soft rollers and balls to rehydrate and restore the body's connective tissue system (fascia). Participants will MELT their feet and use the soft MELT roller to help rehydrate the body, reduce tension, improve mobility and balance, and create a greater sense of ease and wellbeing. 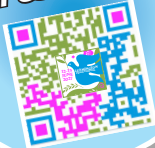

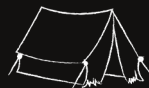

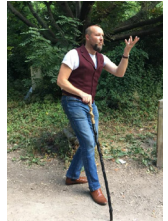
